WHEREAS, Parkinson's affects approximately 17,500 adults in the Province

of British Columbia; and

WHEREAS, Parkinson Society British Columbia is providing information,

consultation, support services and educational seminars for people with Parkinson's and their families; and is promoting a

better understanding of this disorder; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to increase the level of understanding of

Parkinson's and the needs of persons living with Parkinson's.
